PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Pirsch, 4.

Read first time January 10, 2013

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD LEGISLATURE OF
2 NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2014 the
4 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be
5 submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or
6 rejection:

7 To amend Article III, section 13:

8 III-13 The style of all bills shall be, Be it enacted by
9 the people of the State of Nebraska, and no law shall be enacted
10 except by bill. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature unless by
11 the assent of a majority of all members elected to the Legislature
12 and the yeas and nays on the question of final passage of any bill
13 shall be entered upon the journal, except that any bill that imposes
14 a tax or increases the rate of a tax shall require the assent of a
15 majority of all the members elected to the Legislature plus four.

16 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the
17 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,
18 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

1 A constitutional amendment to require that any bill that
2 imposes or increases a tax be approved by a majority of the members
3 of the Legislature plus four.
