The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB209 Statement of Intent/ Summary of the Bill

The intent of LB209 is to update the statutory requirements for registration of a trade name. The bill would delete the current statutory requirement of filing proof of publication for registration of a trade name in the county clerk's office where the principal office is located. The requirement that proof of publication be filed with the Secretary of State's office would remain.

This bill would bring the proof of publication requirements for registration of a trade name in line with many other proof of publication statutes that require filing with the Secretary of State's office only.
