Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 287 would authorize breeders licensed pursuant to the Commercial Dog and Cat Operator Licensure Act to administer rabies vaccination on the breeder's animals if acting within a veterinary care plan as required by section 54-641.02. Such plans must be signed by the breeder's attending veterinarian.

The bill intends that any vaccination performed by a commercial breeder would be part of the veterinary care plan and therefore specifically authorized and instructed by that plan.
