INTRODUCER'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

LB 482

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 482 limits implementation of policies relating to UN Agenda 21, protects the sovereignty of Nebraska, protects the private property rights of its citizens, and preserves the perogatives of the Legislature to legislate statewide land use.

The bill prohibits the State of Nebraska and all political subdivisions within the State of Nebraska from entering into any agreement, expending any sum of money, receiving funds, contracting for services, or giving financial aid to or receiving financial aid from nongovernmental and intergovernmental organizations related to Agenda 21.

UN Agenda 21 is defined as content within “Agenda 21: Programme of Action for Sustainable Development.”
