Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 52 amends Section 83-183 to allow the director of the Department of Correctional Services to enter into arrangements with any charitable, fraternal, or nonprofit corporation for labor services that have a public benefit by persons committed to the incarceration work camp.

Currently, Section 83-183 allows for the director of the Department of Correctional Services to enter into arrangements with any other board or agency of the state, any natural resources district, or any other political subdivision for labor services.

LB 52 seeks to provide the ability for labor services to again be arranged with the type of nonprofit organizations, which previously, had entered into such arrangements in the past for laborers at the Work Ethic Camp.
