SENATOR GLOOR PRESIDING

SENATOR GLOOR: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the twelfth day of the One Hundred Third Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Jim Runnels with the Grace Bible Fellowship Church in Stella, Nebraska, Senator Watermeier's district. Please rise.
