

AMENDMENTS TO LB289

Introduced by Morfeld, 46.

1           1. Strike the original sections and insert the following new  
2 section:

3           Section 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of any law or any  
4 rule or regulation of this state or any political subdivision thereof,  
5 any person who is not otherwise prohibited from transporting, shipping,  
6 or receiving a firearm shall be entitled to transport a firearm for any  
7 lawful purpose from any place where he or she may lawfully possess and  
8 carry such firearm to any other place where he or she may lawfully  
9 possess and carry such firearm, subject to the requirements in subsection  
10 (2) of this section.

11           (2) This section shall apply if, during such transportation, the  
12 firearm is unloaded, and neither the firearm nor any ammunition being  
13 transported is readily accessible or is directly accessible from the  
14 passenger compartment of such transporting vehicle. In the case of a  
15 vehicle without a compartment separate from the driver's compartment, the  
16 firearm or ammunition shall be contained in a locked container other than  
17 the glove compartment or console.
