Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The purpose of Legislative Bill 1051 is to clarify that in Section 77-5715 of the Nebraska Advantage Act for a tier 2, tier 3, tier 4, or tier 5 project, qualified business includes any business engaged in "data analysis."

Explanation of amendments:

The amendment becomes the bill. In addition to adding "data analysis" to the definition of a qualified business activity under the Nebraska Advantage Act, the amendment defines that term.
