Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1080 has four provisions:

Section 1 raises the Department of Correctional Services purchasing authority under section 81-161.03 from \$25,000 to \$50,000.

Section 2 amends section 81-1185 to exclude material used in the production of goods or the provision of services by the correctional industries program of the Department of Correctional Services from the definition of "state government recyclable material."

Section 3 amends section 83-150 to include funds received from recycling of material used in the production of goods or the provision of services by the department's correctional industries program to the funds remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Correctional Industries Revolving fund.

Section 4 repeals the previously operative statutes.
