Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1086 would amend 79-224 (Asthma or anaphylaxis condition; self-management by student; conditions; request; authorization.) to include that in addition to a physician, "other health care professionals who prescribed the medication for the treatment of a student's" asthma or anaphylaxis may sign the medical authorization required for a student to administer their own medication while at school under this section.
