Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 138 names the Land Surveyors Regulation Act in order to provide for the creation of a code of practice for land surveyors to govern their professional conduct.

The code of practice will be made part of the Rules and Regulations of the Nebraska Board of Examiners for Land Surveyors.

The act states that the code of practice for land surveyors will include provisions on:

- Professional competence;
- Conflict of interest;
- Full disclosure of financial interest;
- Full disclosure of matters affecting public safety, health, and welfare;
- Compliance with laws;
- Professional conduct and good character standards, and
- Practice of land surveying.
