Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB297 would provide for a 4.5% salary increase for Nebraska judges in 2015 and 2016.

LB297 would amend 24-201.01 to increase the salaries of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court from \$160,540.25 to \$167,764.00 on July 1, 2015 and to \$175,313.00 on July 1, 2016.

Under 24-1101(3), the salaries for judges of the Court of Appeals are fixed at 95% of the salaries set for the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court. Under LB297, this salary would increase to \$166,547.35 in 2016.

Under 24-301.01 and 48-159, salaries for district court judges, judges of the separate juvenile court and workers compensation court judges are fixed at 92.5% of the salaries set for the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court. Under LB297, this salary would increase to \$162,164.53 in 2016.

Under 24-513, salaries for county court judges are fixed at 90% of the salaries set for the Chief Justice and judges of the Supreme Court. Under LB297, this salary would increase to \$157,781.70 in 2016.

LB663 has also been introduced to increase salaries for Nebraska judges. This bill would increase salaries by 2.25% in
