Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-3,100, issuance of license plates to motor vehicles and trailers.

Current law provides that two license plates shall be issued to a motor vehicle, except that one plate shall be issued to dealers, motorcycles, minitrucks, truck-tractors, buses, apportioned vehicles, and motor vehicles registered as special interest vehicles.

This requirement is amended as follows: beginning January 1, 2017, any passenger car which is not manufactured to be equipped with a bracket on the front to display a license plate may be issued only one license plate upon the request of the individual registering the vehicle. When a request is made a decal shall be issued which shall be displayed on the driver's side of the front windshield. A fee of \$100 is to be charged at the time of the registration of the vehicle.
