**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 577 amends section 23-187 to provide counties may regulate the operation of peddlers, hawkers, or solicitors by the imposition of fees, issuance of a permit, or both. Any permit obtained by the county allows the operation or conduct in all areas of the county where it has jurisdiction.

**Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendment states that counties which adopt an ordinance under this subdivision will not charge a fee and will allow for the operation of a registered party unless otherwise regulated.
