Summary of purpose and/or changes:  This bill would amend Uniform Commercial Code Section 4-403 to allow confirmation or renewal of a stop-payment order to be provided in a "record" rather than in a "writing."  A "record" is defined in UCC Section 1-201 (31) as "information that is inscribed on a tangible medium or that is stored in an electronic or other medium and is retrievable in perceivable form."  The bill carries the emergency clause.
