Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-4,124- issuance of school driving permits.

Current law provides that to be eligible for issuance of the school driving permit, an individual must be younger than 16 years and 3 months and older than 14 years and 2 months of age, live more than 1.5 miles from the school that is attended, and either reside outside a city of the metropolitan, primary, or first class or attend a school which is located outside of a city of the metropolitan, primary, or first class.

The bill would strike from the eligibility criteria the requirement that an applicant for the permit live a distance of 1.5 miles from the school attended.
