Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends 71-1936, of the Children's Residential Facilities and Placing Licensure Act, relating to alleged violations of the act, complaints, investigations, duties, confidentiality, and immunity. Clarifies immunity is not available for those making maliciously false statements to the Department of Health and Human Services. The bill harmonizes the reporter immunity standards with the Child Protection and Family Safety Act.
