Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 864 would change provisions that allow cities of the first class, cities of the second class, and villages to request additional extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction (ETJ) authority from the county.

Under current law, if territory requested by a city or village is within one-half mile of another city or village's ETJ, the county is prohibited from ceding ETJ authority over that territory to the city or village. LB 864 would allow the county to cede ETJ authority over such territory if the other city or village adopts a resolution in support of the request.
