Summary of purpose and/or changes:  LB 865 would amend Nebraska's handicapped parking statutes to change the definition of handicapped or disabled person. Under the bill, individuals who are unable to travel more than 200 feet without stopping would meet the definition of handicapped or disabled person, and would be eligible to apply for a handicapped or disabled parking permit.  LB 865 would also repeal obsolete language in Nebraska's handicapped parking statutes.
