Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB869 was introduced at the request of the Department of Health and Human Services, to align Nebraska statutes with Federal requirements for fingerprinting and background checks of "high risk" Medicaid providers. This legislation is necessary for Nebraska Medicaid to comply with federal regulations (42 CFR 455.434).
