Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 877 amends section 17-1002 to remove the mandatory four week comment period given to county planning commissions to comment on proposed public streets or improvements within a municipality that is entirely within the county, if that municipality has a population between 100,000 and 200,000. The bill preserves the commission's right to officially comment on the proposal if it so chooses.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 2104 makes the following changes to LB 877:

Increases the upper population threshold for counties the bill applies to from 200,000 to 250,000.

Clarifies that the entities that must be provided with the applicable materials are the county planning department and public works department.

Clarifies that the county may officially comment on the appropriateness of the design and improvements proposed in the plat.
