Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 90 is intended to add other options, by allowing the Chairperson of the Health & Human Services Committee, in consultation with the HHS Committee, to ask for a directed review of regulation of a profession or scope of practice.

Section-by-section description:

Section 1: Amends 71-6207.02 of the Nebraska Regulation of Health Professions Act, defining "directed review" to mean a review pursuant to section 71-6223.02.

Section 2: Amends 71-6223.02 to allow the chairperson of the Legislature's Health and Human Services committee, in consultation with committee members, to initiate a directed review. Updates language to further define the applicable committee as the "technical" committee to be in line with existing practice.
