Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 91, brought at the request of the Department of Agriculture, would outright repeal the following series of statutory authorities:

54-724.01 to 54-724.02 -- Provisions governing domestic animals affected with scabies;
54-1401 to 54-1411. -- Provisions pertaining to sheep scabies;
54-1513 to 54-1521 -- Hog Cholera Control and Eradication Act;
54-1501 to 54-1512 -- Relating to the destruction of hog cholera diseased swine;
54-1522 to 54-1523 2013 Relating to double inoculation against hog cholera; and
54-726.04 2013 Relating to imports of swine known or reasonably suspected of infection by any dangerous, infectious, contagious or transmissible disease.
