## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR 394CA would propose an amendment to Article VIII, Section 12 of the Nebraska State Constitution to allow political subdivisions to "opt-out" of having their property tax revenues pledged as part of a redevelopment project that utilizes tax-increment financing (TIF). The proposed amendment would be submitted to the voters at the general election in November 2016.
