Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LR547 calls for a study by the State-Tribal Relations Committee to examine policy tools available to the Legislature to enhance economic development for the Native American population of Nebraska.

The committee is encouraged to seek the input of and meet with members of the Revenue, Appropriations, Education, and Health & Human Services Committees in conducting this study.

The committee is called upon to draft legislation and policy recommendations for consideration by the appropriate standing committee.

Explanation of amendments:

The committee amendment clarifies that the Executive Board shall appoint a special committee to be known as the Tribal Economic Development Committee of the Legislature. The special committee will consist of five members as set forth in the amendment.

Draft legislation and policy recommendations shall be developed by the special committee, along with a report, no later than December 15, 2016.
