LB295 would provide that before municipalities can enforce ordinances, bylaws, rules, regulations and resolutions within the municipalities' extraterritorial zoning jurisdictions, the municipalities must receive approval of the county board in which the extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction is located. Given the myriad of municipal / county extraterritorial jurisdiction relationships as well as possibilities with respect to consideration of ordinance, bylaw, regulation and resolution approval by respective county boards; the fiscal impact of LB295 is indeterminate.
