LB390 requires the University of Nebraska Medical Center to create the Medical Cannabidiol Pilot Study on the efficacy of cannabidiol to treat patients with intractable seizures and treatment resistant seizures. The study is to include at least two neurologists, one of which is to be a pediatric neurologist.

LB390 states the intent of the Legislature to appropriate \$250,000 for FY2015-16 and FY2016-17 from the General Fund for the Medical Cannabidiol Pilot Study.

The University indicates the \$250,000 for FY2015-16 and FY2016-17 will be used to fund a part-time principal investigator, a part-time research coordinator and operating expenses necessary to conduct the study.

The Department of Health and Human Services indicates no fiscal impact.

The State Patrol indicates no fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estimate:

The bill permits medical professionals to conduct limited-scope, evidence-based studies exploring the safety and efficacy of treating intractable seizures and treatment resistant seizures using cannabidiol.

Only UNMC is authorized to produce or possess cannabidiol for research, the cannabidiol must be obtained from or tested at the University of Nebraska Medical Center and dispensed by the Nebraska Medicine Research Pharmacy pursuant to orders of designated medical providers under the UNMC Medical Cannabidiol Pilot Study. Use or possession of cannabidiol under the study is decriminalized, and no agency may remove a child from a home for such use or possession.

UNMC must submit a report to the legislature. It is the intent of the Legistature to appropriate \$250,000 for FY 2015-16 and FY2016-17 to UNMC. The bill sunsets 10-1-2019.

There is no Fiscal Impact to the Department of Health and Human Services.
