Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill, as amended, would change provisions relating to prostitution, and it would also incorporate provisions of LB1097 relating to sexual assault forensic testing. The LB1097 provisions have an operative date of July 1, 2017. The bill also repeals sections 13-607 and 13-608. These sections required the law enforcement agency investigating a reported sexual assault to pay for the cost of a forensic medical examination. Such costs now will be paid for from the Sexual Assault Payment Program Cash Fund, which is created by this bill. The fund shall be administered by the Crime Commission. The fund does not have a revenue source, such as a court fee, but shall consist of any money appropriated to it by the Legislature and any money received by the Crime Commission for the program, including federal and other public and private funds.

The Crime Commission states that it assumes a VOCA (Victims of Crime Act) federal grant will be awarded to pay for 80% of these costs. The VOCA grant requires a match of 20%, which is the General Fund amount. See the agency response following for additional details.

The Supreme Court states that this bill would require additional judicial education on trafficking, but this education can be accomplished with existing funds and staff, so there would be no fiscal impact.

The Attorney General estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

The Nebraska State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from this bill.

The provisions of the bill repealing the sections that required law enforcement agencies to pay the full costs of forensic medical examinations for sexual assault victims should result in a cost savings to such agencies (Nebraska State Patrol and local law enforcement agencies).

Explanation of Estimate: Section 2, subsection (5) of AM2335 to LB 843 requires the Crime Commission to administer the Sexual Assault Payment Program Cash Fund. This fund shall consist of funds appropriated by the Legislature including federal funds. The allowable uses of this fund include the purchase of forensic medical examination kits and payment for forensic medical examinations.

Section 2, subsection (1) of AM2335 eliminates the requirement that the State Patrol shall pay for the cost of a forensic medical examination if the Patrol is the primary investigating law enforcement agency. The State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from this change to the statute which means they are not currently expending any funds for these medical examinations.

State Statute 13-607 requires the law enforcement agency investigating a reported sexual assault to pay for the cost of a forensic medical examination. This statute is repealed by AM2335.

The Attorney General estimates up to 1,000 forensic medical exams are performed in Nebraska each year. AM2335 specifies that the Sexual Assault Payment Program Cash Fund shall be used to pay up to \$200 for the examiner's fee and up to \$300 for the examination facility fee.

The costs for this fiscal note are calculated as follows: 1) 1,000 exam kits at \$35 per kit = \$35,000. 2) 1,000 medical exams at \$500 per exam = \$500,000. 3) Hire a Staff Assistant II to work with staff from the Attorney General's Office and process payments for the medical kits and medical exams. Health insurance is assumed to be family insurance. Total personnel costs = \$63,813. 4) \$8,000 operations cost 5) \$6,000 capital outlay costs (for personal computer, desk, chair, etc.).

This fiscal note assumes a VOCA (Victims of Crime Act) federal grant will be awarded to pay for 80% of these costs. The VOCA grant requires a match of 20%. The match will need to be general or cash funds.

The provisions of this amendment that affect the Crime Commission and Attorney General do not take effect until July 1, 2017.
