This bill, as amended, would make changes to the provisions relating to the Inspector General of Corrections and the Parole Administrator.

The amendment would incorporate provisions of LB690. This bill repeals the restriction on Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) for persons with three or more felony convictions for the possession or use of a controlled substance or a person convicted of a felony involving the sale or distribution of a controlled substance.

SNAP benefits are paid 100% by the federal government. Administrative costs are matched at 50% General and federal. The LB690 fiscal note estimated that a half-time social service worker would be needed. The cost would be \$54,887 (\$27,444 GF and FF) in FY17 and \$52,887 (\$26,444 GF and FF) in FY18.
