1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 236,  
2 Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,  
3 2015; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of  
4 Legislative Bill 265, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,  
5 2015; to change an appropriation; and to repeal the original  
6 section.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 236, Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred Fourth  
2 Legislature, First Session, 2015, is amended to read:

11 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2015-16

16 The unexpended General Fund appropriation balance, less aid, on June  
17 30, 2015, is hereby reappropriated.

18 The Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice  
19 shall contract with the University of Nebraska at Omaha, Juvenile Justice  
20 Institute for \$210,000 in FY2015-16 and \$280,000 in FY2016-17. These  
21 amounts represent the percentages that the University of Nebraska at  
22 Omaha, Juvenile Justice Institute, is to receive as specified in  
23 Legislative Bill 265, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session,  
24 2015.

25 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$263,732 from the General  
26 Fund and \$87,911 from federal funds for FY2015-16 and (2) \$259,232 from  
27 the General Fund and \$86,411 from federal funds for FY2016-17 to the  
28 Foster Care Review Office, for Program 116, to aid in carrying out the  
29 provisions of Legislative Bill 265, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First  
30 Session, 2015.

31 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per

1 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$178,875  
2 for FY2015-16 or \$178,875 for FY2016-17.

3       Sec. 3. Original section 236, Legislative Bill 657, One Hundred  
4 Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015, is repealed.
