1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to claims against the state; to appropriate
2 funds for the payment of certain claims; to provide for payment of
3 the claims; to authorize agencies to write off certain claims as
4 prescribed; and to declare an emergency.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may
2 be required, are hereby appropriated from the General Fund or from other
3 funds as indicated in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for
4 the payment of claims arising out of miscellaneous items of indebtedness
5 owing by the State of Nebraska.

23 Sec. 4. The Director of Administrative Services is hereby
24 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
25 state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several
26 beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their
27 respective names upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
28 several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any
29 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
30 character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its
31 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with

1 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
2 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
3 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
4 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
5 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
6 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
7 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
8 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
