A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to veterans; to amend section 80-410, Reissue
Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide, change, and eliminate
qualifications for officers and personnel of the Department of
Veterans' Affairs, the Veterans' Advisory Commission, and the state
veterans service officers as prescribed; to change a military
service requirement for certain officers and personnel; and to
repeal the original section.

8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 80-410, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
amended to read:

80-410 (1) The Director of Veterans' Affairs, the deputy director, 3 4 all members of the Veterans' Advisory Commission, and all state service 5 officers, all assistant state service officers, and all personnel, except 6 certain special and clerical help, of the state veterans service offices 7 shall have served in the armed forces of the United States during the dates set forth in section 80-401.01 and τ shall have been discharged or 8 9 otherwise separated with a characterization of honorable from such service. A state service officer $\frac{1}{r}$ and shall have been <u>a</u> bona fide 10 resident residents of the State of Nebraska continuously for at least one 11 year five years immediately prior to their assuming his or her a position 12 in any of the offices mentioned. 13

(2) All county veterans service officers shall have served on active 14 duty in the armed forces of the United States, other than active duty for 15 training, shall have been discharged or otherwise separated with a 16 17 characterization of honorable from the service, and shall have been bona fide residents of the State of Nebraska continuously for at least one 18 year immediately prior to assuming any such position, except that if 19 there is no applicant for county veterans service officer in a county who 20 will have been a bona fide resident of the State of Nebraska continuously 21 22 for at least one year prior to assuming such position, the one-year residency requirement may be waived. 23

(3) All members of the county veterans service committees and all personnel, except certain special and clerical help, of the county veterans service offices shall have all of the qualifications described in subsection (2) of this section, except that such persons may have been discharged or otherwise separated with a characterization of general (under honorable conditions).
