1 Section 1. Section 17-102, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 17-102 Unless the city elects council members at large as provided
- 4 in section 32-554, each Each city of the second class shall be divided
- 5 into not less than two nor more than six wards, as may be provided by
- 6 ordinance of the city council. Each thereof; and each ward shall contain,
- 7 as nearly as practicable, an equal portion of the population.
- 8 Sec. 2. Section 17-104, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 9 amended to read:
- 10 17-104 Unless the city elects council members at large as provided
- 11 <u>in section 32-554, each</u> Each ward of each city shall have at least two
- 12 council members elected in the manner provided in the Election Act. The
- 13 term of office shall begin on the first regular meeting of the council in
- 14 December following the statewide general election. No person shall be
- 15 eligible to the office of council member who is not at the time of the
- 16 election an actual resident of the ward for which he or she is elected
- 17 and a registered voter.
- 18 Sec. 3. Original sections 17-102 and 17-104, Reissue Revised
- 19 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
