- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the County Budget Act of 1937; to amend
- 2 section 23-914, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to authorize
- 3 counties to expend funds prior to the adoption of a budget as
- 4 prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an
- 5 emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 23-914, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 23-914 (1) On and after July 1, and until the adoption of the
- 4 budget by the county board in September, the county board may expend any
- 5 balance of cash on hand in any fund for the current expenses of the
- 6 county payable from such fund. Except as provided in subsection (2) of
- 7 this section, such expenditures shall , but not to exceed an amount
- 8 equivalent to such proportion of the total amount expended under the last
- 9 budget for such fund in the equivalent period of the prior budget year—to
- 10 the total amount budgeted for such fund. Such expenditures shall be
- 11 charged against the appropriation for such fund as provided in the budget
- 12 when adopted.
- 13 (2) The restriction on expenditures in subsection (1) of this
- 14 <u>section may be exceeded upon the express finding of the county board that</u>
- 15 expenditures beyond the amount authorized are necessary to enable the
- 16 county to meet its statutory duties and responsibilities. The finding and
- 17 approval of the expenditures in excess of the statutory authorization
- 18 shall be adopted by the county board in open public session of the county
- 19 board. Expenditures authorized by this subsection shall be charged
- 20 against appropriations for each individual fund as provided in the budget
- 21 when adopted, and nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
- 22 authorize expenditures by the county in excess of that authorized by any
- 23 other statutory provision.
- 24 Sec. 2. Original section 23-914, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 25 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 26 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 27 passed and approved according to law.
