- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Public Accountancy Act; to amend
- 2 section 1-136.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to
- 3 change experience requirements; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 1-136.02, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 1-136.02 (1) The board shall issue a permit under subdivision (1)(a)
- 4 of section 1-136 to a holder of a certificate as a certified public
- 5 accountant when such holder has had:
- 6 (a) Two years of accounting experience satisfactory to the board, in
- 7 any state, in employment as an accountant in government, a firm,
- 8 proprietorship, partnership, corporation, limited liability company, or
- 9 other business entity authorized in any state to engage in the practice
- 10 of public accountancy under the supervision of an active certified public
- 11 accountant who is the holder of a permit issued under subdivision (1)(a)
- of section 1-136 or the equivalent issued by another state; or
- 13 (b) Three years of accounting experience satisfactory to the board,
- 14 in any state, in employment as (i) an accountant in government or
- 15 business under the supervision of an active certified public accountant
- 16 who is the holder of a permit issued under subdivision (1)(a) of section
- 17 1-136 or the equivalent issued by another state or (ii) faculty at a
- 18 college or university of recognized standing under the supervision of an
- 19 active certified public accountant who is the holder of a permit issued
- 20 under subdivision (1)(a) of section 1-136 or the equivalent issued by
- 21 another state.
- 22 (2) The board shall issue a permit under subdivision (1)(a) of
- 23 section 1-136 to a holder of a reciprocal certificate issued under
- 24 section 1-124 upon a showing that:
- 25 (a) He or she meets all current requirements in this state for
- 26 issuance of a permit at the time the application is made; and
- 27 (b) At the time of the application for a permit the applicant,
- 28 within the ten years immediately preceding application, meets the
- 29 experience requirement in subdivision (1)(a) or (b) of this section.
