- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
- 2 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to prohibit
- 3 flying lanterns; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
- 4 section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
2 2014, is amended to read:

3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357, 28-1418.01, and 28-1429.03 and  
4 section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska  
5 Criminal Code.

6 Sec. 2. (1) Flying lantern-type devices are prohibited from sale,  
7 possession, and use in this state.

8 (2) For purposes of this section, flying lantern-type devices means  
9 devices that require a flame which produces heated air trapped in a  
10 balloon-type covering allowing the device to float in the air. Flying  
11 lantern-type devices shall not include hot-air balloons used for  
12 transporting persons.

13 (3) A violation of this section is a Class V misdemeanor.

14 Sec. 3. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
15 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.
