## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 224**

Introduced by Harr, 8.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to electioneering; to amend section 32-1524, 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 32-101, Revised 3 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to require the marking of 4 areas near polling places for purposes electioneering of 5 restrictions prescribed; as to change restrictions 6 electioneering; to prohibit removal of or refusal to display

electioneering materials as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and

9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

to repeal the original sections.

1 Section 1. Section 32-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 32-101 Sections 32-101 to 32-1551 and section 2 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Election Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. (1) On the day of any election conducted by the election
- 6 <u>commissioner or county clerk pursuant to the Election Act, the election</u>
- 7 commissioner or county clerk shall cause flags to be placed to indicate
- 8 <u>the area within two hundred feet, up to but not across a public</u>
- 9 thoroughfare or private property, other than the property upon which the
- 10 <u>building</u> is located, of any part of a building in which one or more
- 11 polling places are being used at such election.
- 12 (2) The owner of a building in which a polling place is located
- 13 <u>shall allow electioneering materials to be displayed on the same property</u>
- 14 as the building outside of the area flagged pursuant to subsection (1) of
- 15 this section and shall allow campaign yard signs within the yard-sign
- 16 zone designated pursuant to subsection (3) of this section.
- 17 (3) The election commissioner or county clerk shall, in consultation
- 18 with the owner or property manager of the building, designate a yard-sign
- 19 zone for each building in which one or more polling places are located.
- 20 The election commissioner or county clerk shall cause the yard-sign zone
- 21 to be clearly marked at least one hour prior to the opening of the polls.
- 22 The yard-sign zone shall be within the two-hundred-foot area marked by
- 23 flags pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, shall be an area as
- 24 <u>near as possible to ten feet by five feet, and shall be visible</u> to voters
- 25 entering the building to vote.
- 26 <u>(4) Any person may display a campaign sign in a yard-sign zone</u>
- 27 <u>beginning at 7 a.m. and ending at 9 p.m. on the day of an election.</u>
- Sec. 3. Section 32-1524, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 30 32-1524 (1) No judge or clerk of election or precinct or district
- 31 inspector shall do any electioneering while acting as an election

- 1 official.
- 2 (2) No person shall <u>display electioneering materials or do any</u>
- 3 electioneering, circulate petitions, or perform any action that involves
- 4 solicitation within any polling place or any building designated for
- 5 voters to cast ballots by the election commissioner or county clerk
- 6 pursuant to the Election Act while the polling place or building is set
- 7 up for voters to cast ballots or within two hundred feet of any such
- 8 polling place or building.
- 9 (3) Except as provided in section 2 of this act for yard-sign zones,
- 10 no person shall display electioneering materials or do any
- 11 electioneering, circulate petitions, or perform any action that involves
- 12 <u>solicitation within two hundred feet, up to but not across a public</u>
- 13 thoroughfare or private property, other than the property upon which the
- 14 <u>building is located, of any part of a building in which any polling place</u>
- 15 <u>is located as designated by the election commissioner or county clerk</u>
- 16 pursuant to section 2 of this act beginning at 7 a.m. and ending at 9
- 17 p.m. on the day of any election conducted pursuant to the Election Act.
- 18 <u>(4) No person shall remove any lawfully displayed electioneering</u>
- 19 materials without authorization.
- 20 (5) It shall be unlawful for the owner of a building in which a
- 21 polling place is located or his or her designee to (a) refuse to allow
- 22 electioneering materials to be lawfully displayed on the same property as
- 23 the building as provided in section 2 of this act or (b) allow
- 24 <u>electioneering materials which are lawfully displayed as provided in</u>
- 25 section 2 of this act to be removed without approval prior to the close
- 26 <u>of the polls.</u>
- 27 (6) Any person violating this section shall be quilty of a Class IV
- 28 ¥ misdemeanor.
- 29 Sec. 4. Original section 32-1524, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 30 Nebraska, and section 32-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 31 2014, are repealed.
