- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 28-101,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to establish the
- 3 offense of false presentation of proof of liability insurance; to
- 4 provide penalties; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2 2014, is amended to read:

3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357, 28-1418.01, and 28-1429.03 and
4 section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
5 Criminal Code.

6 Sec. 2. (1) A person commits the offense of false presentation if
7 he or she presents, displays, or furnishes expired, cancelled, fake,
8 counterfeit, false, or misleading evidence of an automobile liability
9 policy, evidence of insurance, or proof of financial responsibility to
10 any peace officer, prosecuting attorney, or other official with the
11 intent to impede a criminal investigation or proceeding, to acquire a
12 motor vehicle registration pursuant to section 60-528, or to avoid
13 prosecution under section 60-3,167.

14 (2) A person convicted of a violation of this section shall be
15 guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.

16 (3) The court may, as a part of the judgment of conviction, order
17 such person not to operate any motor vehicle for any purpose for a period
18 of up to one year from the date ordered by the court, and order the
19 operator's license of such person to be revoked for a like period.
