- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Medical Assistance Act; to amend
- 2 section 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2014; to
- 3 provide for a study of rates for care provided by an Alzheimer's
- 4 special care unit as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; to repeal
- 5 the original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2014, is amended to read:
- 3 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-974 and section 2 of this act shall be
- 4 known and may be cited as the Medical Assistance Act.
- 5 Sec. 2. <u>(1) The Division of Medicaid and Long-Term Care of the</u>
- 6 Department of Health and Human Services shall contract for a study to
- 7 determine an appropriate rate for payment under the medicaid waiver for
- 8 <u>the aged and disabled for care for individuals with Alzheimer's disease</u>
- 9 or other dementia provided by an Alzheimer's special care unit as defined
- 10 <u>in section 71-516.03 in an assisted-living facility as defined in section</u>
- 11 <u>71-406. The department shall publish the report on its web site on or</u>
- 12 <u>before July 1, 2015, and shall electronically inform the Governor and the</u>
- 13 <u>Clerk of the Legislature when the report is available.</u>
- 14 (2) The study shall include an analysis of:
- 15 (a) The actual cost of providing care in an Alzheimer's special care
- 16 <u>unit as defined in section 71-516.03 in an assisted-living facility as</u>
- 17 defined in section 71-406;
- 18 <u>(b) The differences in cost between such units which may be</u>
- 19 <u>attributable to geographic location or other factors;</u>
- 20 <u>(c) Best practices in the provision of care in an Alzheimer's</u>
- 21 <u>special care unit in an assisted-living facility;</u>
- 22 (d) Medicaid reimbursement for the type of care provided by an
- 23 Alzheimer's special care unit in a nursing facility as defined in section
- 24 71-424 or a skilled nursing facility as defined in section 71-429, for
- 25 purposes of comparison;
- 26 <u>(e) The advantages and disadvantages of an add-on medicaid waiver</u>
- 27 <u>rate structure or a tiered medicaid waiver rate structure;</u>
- 28 (f) The number of persons likely to use services of an Alzheimer's
- 29 special care unit in an assisted-living facility if reimbursement is
- 30 changed pursuant to the appropriate rate as determined by this study;
- 31 (g) The eligibility criteria for receiving the appropriate rate by

- 1 an Alzheimer's special care unit in an assisted-living facility;
- 2 (h) The eligibility criteria for clients to have their care
- 3 reimbursed at the appropriate rate, including an assessment tool, a rate
- 4 period, and an approval process for the clients; and
- 5 (i) An evaluation process to identify desired client outcomes and
- 6 service quality for Alzheimer's special care units in assisted-living
- 7 <u>facilities</u>.
- 8 (3) The division shall make data reasonably required for the study
- 9 available to the contractor. The department may approve access by the
- 10 contractor to case-specific data or case-specific and patient-identifying
- 11 <u>data to assist in the study. Any information released for the study shall</u>
- 12 <u>be disclosed as provided in sections 81-663 to 81-675.</u>
- 13 (4) The cost of the study shall not exceed fifty thousand dollars.
- 14 Sec. 3. Original section 68-901, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 15 Supplement, 2014, is repealed.
- 16 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 17 passed and approved according to law.
