- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$77,164 from the State
- 2 Patrol Retirement Act Expense Fund for FY2016-17 to the Public Employees
- 3 Retirement Board, for Program 41, to aid in carrying out the provisions
- 4 of Legislative Bill 467, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session,
- 5 2016.
- 6 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 7 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 8 section.
- 9 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$17,630 from the General
- 10 Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$25,999 from the General Fund for FY2017-18 to
- 11 the Nebraska State Patrol, for Program 100, to aid in carrying out the
- 12 provisions of Legislative Bill 467, One Hundred Fourth Legislature,
- 13 <u>Second Session, 2016.</u>
- 14 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 15 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 16 section.
- 17 Sec. 3. <u>There is hereby appropriated (1) \$5,877 from the Carrier</u>
- 18 Enforcement Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$8,666 from the Carrier
- 19 <u>Enforcement Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Nebraska State Patrol, for</u>
- 20 Program 205, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
- 21 467, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.
- 22 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 23 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 24 section.
- 25 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 26 passed and approved according to law.
