- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to prohibit employers and
2 associations from precluding certain contracts relating to health
3 benefit plans; and to provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes.
4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision within Chapter 44,
2 an employer or association shall not be precluded from entering into any
3 contract, agreement, or arrangement with an agent or broker that provides
4 for or results in compensation paid to an agent or broker for the sale of
5 a health benefit plan. Such contract, agreement, or arrangement shall be
6 in writing and shall specify the compensation amount to be paid and the
7 term of such contract, agreement, or arrangement. Such compensation may
8 be collected by and directly passed through to the agent or broker by the
9 carrier and shall not be considered a part of the premium paid by the
10 employer for such health benefit plan.

11 Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of this act
12 to Chapter 44, article 3.
