Introduced by Speaker Hadley, 37; at the request of the Governor.

Committee: Appropriations

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
- 2 the payment of the salaries and benefits of certain state officers
- 3 for FY2015-16 and FY2016-17; to define terms; to provide an
- 4 operative date; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.

2 There are hereby appropriated, for FY2015-16 and FY2016-17, the
3 amounts specified in this act, or so much as may be necessary, for the
4 salaries and benefits of officers of the Nebraska state government.

5 Sec. 2. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.

6 For purposes of this act, FY2014-15 means the period beginning July
7 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015, FY2015-16 means the period beginning
8 July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016, and FY2016-17 means the period
9 beginning July 1, 2016, and ending June 30, 2017.

10 Sec. 3. NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.

11 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting System Manual,
12 and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk of the Legislature are
13 hereby adopted by the Legislature as the definitions for this act, except
14 as provided in section 21 of this act.

15 Sec. 4. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.

16 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw warrants upon the
17 proper fund in the state treasury for an amount not to exceed the
18 appropriations set forth in this act upon presentation of proper
19 documentation. The State Treasurer shall pay the warrants out of the
20 appropriate funds.

21 Workers' compensation premium assessments shall not be paid from the
22 programs listed in this act.

19 of statewide court operations and the proper administration of justice.
20 The Salary Limit for Agency 5, Program 5, may be administratively
21 increased for any transfers made to Program 5 pursuant to this section.

 29 salary limit is insufficient in this program to meet anticipated
 30 expenditures, the Tax Commissioner shall request additional funds or a

1 higher salary limit, or both, from the Legislature by the usual deficit
2 process. The appropriation or the salary limit shall not be
3 administratively increased solely by the Department of Administrative
4 Services without legislative authorization.

17 Sec. 21. LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.

18 (1) As used in this act:

19 (a) SALARY LIMIT means total expenditures for permanent and
20 temporary salaries and per diems; and

21 (b) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
22 diems means all remuneration paid to employees treated as taxable
23 compensation by the Internal Revenue Service or subject to social
24 security coverage, specifically including payments accounted for as
25 vacation, holidays, sick leave, military leave, funeral leave, maternity
26 leave, administrative leave, compensatory time, deferred compensation, or
27 any other similar form, and amounts withheld pursuant to law, but
28 excluding state contributions for social security, retirement, and
29 employee insurance plans.

30 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
31 diems are limited to the amount provided by law for constitutional

1 officers.

2 (3) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
3 salaries and per diems for FY2015-16 shall be increased by certified
4 encumbrance amounts from FY2014-15 for permanent and temporary salaries
5 and per diems. The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
6 salaries and per diems for FY2016-17 shall be increased by certified
7 encumbrance amounts from FY2015-16 for permanent and temporary salaries
8 and per diems. Encumbered amounts shall be calculated in accordance with
9 section 81-138.01.

10 Sec. 22. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2015.

11 Sec. 23. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
12 passed and approved according to law.
