- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to law; to amend section 49-501.01, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for the publication and
- 3 distribution of the Constitution of Nebraska; to harmonize
- 4 provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (6) of this
- 2 <u>section, following each regular session of the Legislature, the Revisor</u>
- 3 of Statutes shall compile an updated copy of the Constitution of
- 4 Nebraska, showing all sections as they exist at that time and including
- 5 notes after the end of each section as follows:
- 6 (a) For each section, the Revisor of Statutes shall provide a note
- 7 referencing the source of such section and any amendments thereto;
- 8 (b) If a section is declared unconstitutional or inoperative, in
- 9 whole or in part, by the final judgment of a federal court or the
- 10 Nebraska Supreme Court, the Revisor of Statutes shall provide a note to
- 11 that effect. The Attorney General shall assist the Revisor of Statutes in
- 12 <u>complying with this subdivision by promptly notifying the Revisor of</u>
- 13 <u>Statutes when any section is declared unconstitutional or inoperative;</u>
- 14 and
- (c) For any section, the Revisor of Statutes may provide additional
- 16 notes at his or her discretion.
- 17 (2) The Revisor of Statutes shall, within two days after the
- 18 Legislature has adjourned sine die, transmit the updated copy of the
- 19 Constitution of Nebraska as compiled under subsection (1) of this section
- 20 to the Secretary of State for his or her review to determine whether the
- 21 updated copy accurately reflects the Constitution of Nebraska as it
- 22 exists at that time. If the Secretary of State determines that any
- 23 changes are necessary, he or she shall, within five days after receipt of
- 24 the updated copy, notify the Revisor of Statutes of the changes. The
- 25 Revisor of Statutes shall make such changes and then promptly return the
- 26 updated copy to the Secretary of State for further review. If the
- 27 Secretary of State determines that no changes are necessary or that all
- 28 <u>necessary changes have been made by the Revisor of Statutes, the</u>
- 29 Secretary of State shall certify the updated copy as an accurate
- 30 reflection of the Constitution of Nebraska as it exists at that time. The
- 31 Secretary of State shall then transmit the certified copy to the Clerk of

1 the Legislature for distribution no later than ten days after the

- 2 <u>Legislature has adjourned sine die.</u>
- 3 (3) After receiving the certified copy of the Constitution of
- 4 Nebraska from the Secretary of State pursuant to subsection (2) of this
- 5 section, the Clerk of the Legislature shall:
- 6 (a) Make the certified copy available in electronic form on the
- 7 Legislature's web site;
- 8 (b) Include the certified copy in the session laws compiled and
- 9 <u>published pursuant to section 49-501.01; and</u>
- 10 (c) Print pamphlets of the certified copy for distribution to the
- 11 <u>public upon request.</u>
- 12 <u>(4) The certified copies printed by the Clerk of the Legislature</u>
- 13 pursuant to subdivisions (3)(b) and (3)(c) of this section shall
- 14 constitute the official version of the Constitution of Nebraska and may
- 15 be cited as prima facie evidence of the law in all courts of this state.
- 16 <u>(5) The Secretary of State shall maintain in his or her office a</u>
- 17 copy of every edition of the Constitution of Nebraska certified pursuant
- 18 to this section.
- 19 (6) Following any regular session of the Legislature, if the Revisor
- 20 of Statutes determines that there have been no changes to the
- 21 Constitution of Nebraska and no changes to the notes required by
- 22 subsection (1) of this section, the Revisor of Statutes may decide not to
- 23 compile an updated copy of the Constitution of Nebraska for that year. If
- 24 the Revisor of Statutes decides not to compile an updated copy for the
- 25 year, he or she shall notify the Secretary of State and the Clerk of the
- 26 <u>Legislature of such fact and the Clerk of the Legislature shall continue</u>
- 27 to use the most recent year's certified copy for purposes of subsection
- 28 (3) of this section.
- 29 Sec. 2. Section 49-501.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 30 amended to read:
- 31 49-501.01 The session laws and journal of the Legislature shall be

- 1 compiled and published by the Clerk of the Legislature after each regular session of the Legislature. The session laws and journal may be published 2 3 in print or electronic format or in both formats. The session laws shall contain all the laws passed by the preceding session as well as those 4 passed during any special session since the last regular session. The 5 session laws shall also contain a certified copy of the Constitution of 6 Nebraska as required by section 1 of this act. The clerk shall distribute 7 8 one copy of the session laws and journal to each person who was a member 9 of the Legislature by which the laws were enacted and shall distribute a second copy to any such person upon his or her request. The clerk shall 10 provide the session laws and journals to the Secretary of State for 11
- Sec. 3. Original section 49-501.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
