Section 1. A person who holds a cigar shop license under the

Nebraska Liquor Control Act shall pay a tax of one percent on each sale

of tobacco made pursuant to the license. The tax shall be computed,

determined, assessed, and collected in the same manner as provided for

the sales and use taxes in the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967. The Tax

Commissioner shall remit the taxes collected under this section to the

7 State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund.
