- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public meetings; to amend section 84-1413,
- 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to authorize electronic voting
- devices for natural resources districts; and to repeal the original
- 4 section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 84-1413, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-1413 (1) Each public body shall keep minutes of all meetings
- 4 showing the time, place, members present and absent, and the substance of
- 5 all matters discussed.
- 6 (2) Any action taken on any question or motion duly moved and
- 7 seconded shall be by roll call vote of the public body in open session,
- 8 and the record shall state how each member voted or if the member was
- 9 absent or not voting. The requirements of a roll call or viva voce vote
- 10 shall be satisfied by a municipality, a county, a learning community, a
- 11 <u>natural resources district,</u> a joint entity created pursuant to the
- 12 Interlocal Cooperation Act, a joint public agency created pursuant to the
- 13 Joint Public Agency Act, or an agency formed under the Municipal
- 14 Cooperative Financing Act which utilizes an electronic voting device
- 15 which allows the yeas and nays of each member of such city council,
- 16 village board, county board, natural resources district board, or
- 17 governing body to be readily seen by the public.
- 18 (3) The vote to elect leadership within a public body may be taken
- 19 by secret ballot, but the total number of votes for each candidate shall
- 20 be recorded in the minutes.
- 21 (4) The minutes of all meetings and evidence and documentation
- 22 received or disclosed in open session shall be public records and open to
- 23 public inspection during normal business hours.
- 24 (5) Minutes shall be written, except as provided in subsection (6)
- 25 of this section, and available for inspection within ten working days or
- 26 prior to the next convened meeting, whichever occurs earlier, except that
- 27 cities of the second class and villages may have an additional ten
- 28 working days if the employee responsible for writing the minutes is
- 29 absent due to a serious illness or emergency.
- 30 (6) Minutes of the meetings of the board of a school district or
- 31 educational service unit may be kept as an electronic record.
