- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to law enforcement; to prohibit the use of
- 2 cell-site simulator technology or devices by law enforcement
- 3 agencies as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB738 2016

- 1 Section 1. (1) No law enforcement agency shall purchase or use
- 2 <u>cell-site simulator technology or devices. Any law enforcement agency</u>
- 3 that currently possesses or uses cell-site simulator technology or
- 4 devices shall discontinue such use and discard the technology or devices.
- 5 (2) For purposes of this section, cell-site simulator means
- 6 technology or devices that transmit or receive radio waves for the
- 7 purpose of conducting one or more of the following operations:
- 8 (a) Identifying, locating, or tracking the movements of a
- 9 communications device;
- 10 <u>(b) Intercepting, obtaining, accessing, or forwarding the</u>
- 11 <u>communications</u>, stored data, or metadata of a communications device;
- 12 (c) Affecting the hardware or software operations or functions of a
- 13 <u>communications device;</u>
- 14 (d) Forcing transmissions from or connections to a communications
- 15 device;
- 16 (e) Denying a communications device access to other communications
- 17 <u>devices, communications protocols, or services; or</u>
- 18 (f) Spoofing or simulating a communications device, cell tower, cell
- 19 site, or service, including, but not limited to, an international mobile
- 20 <u>subscriber identity catcher or other invasive cell phone or telephone</u>
- 21 surveillance or eavesdropping device that mimics a cell phone tower and
- 22 sends out signals to cause cell phones in the area to transmit their
- 23 locations, identifying information, and communication content, or a
- 24 passive interception device or digital analyzer that does not send
- 25 signals to a communications device under surveillance.
