Read first time January 06, 2016 Committee: Transportation and Telecommunications A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act; 1 2 to amend section 60-154, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 3 2014; to increase original certificate of title fees for vehicles 4 transferred to Nebraska from another state; to provide for 5 distribution of such fees; and to repeal the original section. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska, 6

Section 1. Section 60-154, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2014, is amended to read:

60-154 (1)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (1)(b) of this 3 section, for For each original certificate of title issued by a county 4 for a motor vehicle or trailer, the fee shall be ten dollars. Three 5 dollars and twenty-five cents shall be retained by the county. Four 6 7 dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars shall be remitted to 8 9 the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. Seventy-five cents shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit as follows: Twenty 10 cents to the Motor Vehicle Fraud Cash Fund; forty-five cents to the 11 Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund; and ten cents to the Nebraska Motor 12 Vehicle Industry Licensing Fund. 13

(b) For each original certificate of title issued by a county for a 14 motor vehicle or trailer being titled in Nebraska from another state or 15 country, the fee shall be twenty-five dollars. Twelve dollars and fifty 16 cents shall be retained by the county. Six dollars shall be remitted to 17 the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash 18 19 Fund. Four dollars and fifty cents shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. One dollar shall be remitted to 20 the State Treasurer for credit to the Health and Human Services Cash Fund 21 for use by the Department of Health and Human Services for programs for 22 persons suffering from a brain injury. One dollar shall be remitted to 23 24 the State Treasurer for credit as follows: Twenty-five cents to the Motor 25 Vehicle Fraud Cash Fund; sixty-five cents to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund; and ten cents to the Nebraska Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing 26 27 Fund.

(2)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (2)(b) of this section, for
 (b) For each original certificate of title issued by a county for an all terrain vehicle, a utility-type vehicle, or a minibike, the fee shall be
 ten dollars. Three dollars and twenty-five cents shall be retained by the

1 county. Four dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit 2 to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Two dollars shall be 3 remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. Seventy-4 five cents shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit as 5 follows: Twenty cents to the Motor Vehicle Fraud Cash Fund; and fifty-6 five cents to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund.

7 (b) For each original certificate of title issued by a county for an all-terrain vehicle, a utility-type vehicle, or a minibike being titled 8 9 in Nebraska from another state or country, the fee shall be twenty-five 10 dollars. Twelve dollars and fifty cents shall be retained by the county. Six dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the 11 Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Four dollars and fifty cents 12 13 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the General Fund. One dollar shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the 14 15 Health and Human Services Cash Fund for use by the Department of Health and Human Services for programs for persons suffering from a brain 16 17 injury. One dollar shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit as follows: Twenty-five cents to the Motor Vehicle Fraud Cash Fund; and 18 19 seventy-five cents to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund.

(3)(a) Except as provided in subdivision (3)(b) of this section and
in section 60-159.01, for (2) For each original certificate of title
issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles department for a vehicle
except as provided in section 60-159.01, the fee shall be ten dollars.
Four dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. Six dollars shall be remitted to
the State Treasurer for credit to the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund.

(b) For each original certificate of title issued by the department
for a vehicle titled in Nebraska from another state or country, the fee
shall be twenty-five dollars. Ten dollars shall be remitted to the State
Treasurer for credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.
Fourteen dollars shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to
