- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to require school districts to
- 2 prepare for the closure of nonpublic schools as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB781 2016

- 1 Section 1. (1) Every three years beginning with 2016, the school
- 2 board of each school district having within its boundaries one or more
- 3 accredited nonpublic schools shall estimate the cost per student to the
- 4 school district for each of the ensuing three years to absorb the
- 5 <u>students enrolled in such nonpublic schools into the school district in</u>
- 6 <u>the event of closure of such nonpublic schools.</u>
- 7 (2) The school district shall prepare for the closure of such
- 8 <u>nonpublic schools in one of the following ways:</u>
- 9 <u>(a) Add sufficient capacity to its physical facilities to</u>
- 10 <u>immediately absorb the students enrolled in such nonpublic schools;</u>
- 11 (b) Place in reserve sufficient funds to cover seventy-five percent
- 12 <u>of the anticipated operating cost of absorbing such students for the</u>
- 13 <u>ensuing three-year period; or</u>
- 14 (c) Contract with the operating entity of each such nonpublic school
- 15 to have the nonpublic school continue in operation for such three-year
- 16 period, in exchange for which the school district shall, for each year of
- 17 <u>such three-year period, pay to the operating entity a sum equal to ten</u>
- 18 percent of the cost per year of absorbing the nonpublic school's students
- 19 into the educational operation of the school district as estimated
- 20 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section. Such contract shall include
- 21 the requirement that such operating entity pledge sufficient assets or
- 22 guarantees from a financial institution or other financially able person
- 23 or benefactor to pay for seventy-five percent of the estimated cost of
- 24 <u>such nonpublic school continuing in operation for such three-year period.</u>
- 25 Such contract shall provide that the operating entity shall provide the
- 26 <u>school district at least one year's notice prior to closure. If the</u>
- 27 <u>contract will expire in less than a year, the operating entity of the</u>
- 28 <u>nonpublic school shall notify the school district of its intention to</u>
- 29 <u>cease operation as soon as possible.</u>
- 30 (3) The State Department of Education shall reimburse the school
- 31 district for fifty percent of the costs incurred by the district pursuant

1 to subdivision (2)(c) of this section. Such costs shall not be considered

- 2 when calculating the formula need of such district for purposes of
- 3 <u>sections 79-1007.04 to 79-1007.23 and 79-1007.25.</u>
