- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to amend sections 84-602
- 2 and 84-602.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
- 3 84-602.02, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015; to change the Taxpayer
- 4 Transparency Act; to define and redefine terms; to harmonize
- 5 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 84-602, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 84-602 It shall be the duty of the State Treasurer:
- 4 (1) To receive and keep all money of the state not expressly
- 5 required to be received and kept by some other person;
- 6 (2) To disburse the public money upon warrants drawn upon the state
- 7 treasury according to law and not otherwise;
- 8 (3) To keep a just, true, and comprehensive account of all money
- 9 received and disbursed;
- 10 (4) To keep a just account with each fund, and each head of
- 11 appropriation made by law, and the warrants drawn against them;
- 12 (5) To render a full statement to the Department of Administrative
- 13 Services of all money received by him or her from whatever source, and if
- 14 on account of revenue, for what year; of all penalties and interest on
- 15 delinquent taxes reported or accounted for to him or her, and of all
- 16 disbursements of public funds; with a list, in numerical order, of all
- 17 warrants redeemed, the name of the payee, amount, interest, and total
- 18 amount allowed thereon, and with the amount of the balance of the several
- 19 funds unexpended; which statement shall be made on the first day of
- 20 December, March, June, and September, and more often if required;
- 21 (6) To report electronically to the Legislature as soon as
- 22 practicable, but within ten days after the commencement of each regular
- 23 session, a detailed statement of the condition of the treasury and its
- 24 operations for the preceding fiscal year;
- 25 (7) To give information electronically to the Legislature, whenever
- 26 required, upon any subject connected with the treasury or touching any
- 27 duty of his or her office;
- 28 (8) To account for, and pay over, all money received by him or her
- 29 as such treasurer, to his or her successor in office, and deliver all
- 30 books, vouchers, and effects of office to him or her; and such successor
- 31 shall receipt therefor. In accounting for and paying over such money the

- 1 treasurer shall not be held liable on account of any loss occasioned by
- 2 any investment, when such investment shall have been made pursuant to the
- 3 direction of the state investment officer; and
- 4 (9) To develop and maintain the a single, searchable web site
- 5 <u>required under the Taxpayer Transparency Act</u> with information on state
- 6 tax receipts, expenditures, and contracts which is accessible by the
- 7 public at no cost to access as provided in section 84-602.02. The web
- 8 site shall be hosted on a server owned and operated by the State of
- 9 Nebraska or approved by the Chief Information Officer. The naming
- 10 convention for the web site shall identify the web site as a state
- 11 government web site. The web site shall not include the treasurer's name,
- 12 the treasurer's image, the treasurer's seal, or a welcome message.
- 13 Sec. 2. Section 84-602.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 14 amended to read:
- 15 84-602.01 (1) Sections 84-602.01 and The establishment of the web
- 16 site provided for in section 84-602 and described in section 84-602.02
- 17 shall be known and may be cited as the Taxpayer Transparency Act.
- 18 (2) For purposes of the Taxpayer Transparency Act:
- 19 (a)(i) Expenditure of state funds means all expenditures of state
- 20 receipts, whether appropriated or nonappropriated, by a state entity in
- 21 <u>forms including, but not limited to:</u>
- 22 <u>(A) Grants;</u>
- 23 (B) Contracts;
- 24 (C) Subcontracts;
- 25 (D) State aid to political subdivisions;
- 26 (E) Tax refunds or credits that may be disclosed pursuant to the
- 27 <u>Nebraska Advantage Act, the Nebraska Advantage Microenterprise Tax Credit</u>
- 28 Act, the Nebraska Advantage Research and Development Act, or the Nebraska
- 29 Advantage Rural Development Act; and
- 30 (F) Any other disbursement of state receipts by a state entity in
- 31 the performance of its functions.

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- 1 (ii) Expenditure of state funds does not include the transfer of
- 2 <u>funds between two state entities, payments of state or federal assistance</u>
- 3 to an individual, or the expenditure of pass-through funds;
- 4 (b) Pass-through funds means any funds received by a state entity if
- 5 the state entity is acting only as an intermediary or custodian with
- 6 respect to such funds and is obligated to pay or otherwise return such
- 7 funds to the person entitled thereto;
- 8 (c) State entity means (i) any agency, board, commission, or
- 9 department of the state and (ii) any other body created by state statute
- 10 that includes a person appointed by the Governor, the head of any state
- 11 agency or department, an employee of the State of Nebraska, or any
- 12 <u>combination of such persons and that is empowered pursuant to such</u>
- 13 <u>statute to collect and disburse state receipts; and</u>
- 14 (d) State receipts means revenue or other income which is received
- 15 by a state entity from tax receipts, fees, charges, interest, or other
- 16 sources and which is used by the state entity to pay the expenses
- 17 necessary to perform the state entity's functions. State receipts does
- 18 not include pass-through funds.
- 19 Sec. 3. Section 84-602.02, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2015, is
- 20 amended to read:
- 21 84-602.02 (1) The State Treasurer shall develop and maintain a
- 22 single, searchable web site with information on state receipts,
- 23 expenditures of state funds, and contracts which is accessible by the
- 24 public at no cost to access as provided in this section. The web site
- 25 shall be hosted on a server owned and operated by the State of Nebraska
- 26 <u>or approved by the Chief Information Officer. The naming convention for</u>
- 27 <u>the web site shall identify the web site as a state government web site.</u>
- 28 The web site shall not include the treasurer's name, the treasurer's
- 29 <u>image</u>, the treasurer's seal, or a welcome message.
- 30 (2)(a) The (1)(a) Not later than January 1, 2010, the web site
- 31 established, developed, and maintained by the State Treasurer pursuant to

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- 1 this section subdivision (9) of section 84-602 shall provide such
- 2 information as will document the sources of all state tax receipts and
- 3 the expenditure of state funds by all agencies, boards, commissions, and
- 4 departments of the state entities.
- 5 (b) The State Treasurer shall, in appropriate detail, cause to be
- 6 published on the web site:
- 7 (i) The identity, principal location, and amount of <u>state receipts</u>
- 8 funds received or expended by the State of Nebraska and all of its state
- 9 <u>entities</u> agencies, boards, commissions, and departments;
- 10 (ii) The funding or expending state entity agency, board,
- 11 commission, or department;
- 12 (iii) The budget program source;
- 13 (iv) The amount, date, purpose, and recipient of all <u>expenditures of</u>
- 14 state funds disbursed funds; and
- 15 (v) Such other relevant information as will further the intent of
- 16 enhancing the transparency of state government financial operations to
- 17 its citizens and taxpayers. The web site shall include data for fiscal
- 18 year 2008-09 and each fiscal year thereafter, except that for any state
- 19 entity that becomes subject to this section due to the changes made by
- 20 this legislative bill, the web site shall include data for such state
- 21 entity for fiscal year 2016-17 and each fiscal year thereafter.
- 22 (3 2) The Beginning July 1, 2010, the data shall be available on the
- 23 web site no later than thirty days after the end of the preceding fiscal
- 24 year.
- 25 (4)(a) The (3)(a) Beginning July 1, 2014, the web site described in
- 26 this section shall include a link to the web site of the Department of
- 27 Administrative Services. The department's web site shall contain:
- 28 (i) A data base that includes a copy of each active contract that is
- 29 a basis for an expenditure of state funds, including any amendment to
- 30 such contract and any document incorporated by reference in such
- 31 contract. For purposes of this subdivision, amendment means an agreement

- 1 to modify a contract which has been reduced to writing and signed by each
- 2 party to the contract, an agreement to extend the duration of a contract,
- 3 or an agreement to renew a contract. The data base shall be accessible by
- 4 the public and searchable by vendor, by state entity agency, board,
- 5 commission, or department, and by dollar amount. All agencies, boards,
- 6 commissions, and departments of the state entities shall provide to the
- 7 Department of Administrative Services, in electronic form, copies of such
- 8 contracts for inclusion in the data base beginning with contracts that
- 9 are active on and after January 1, 2014, except that for any state entity
- 10 that becomes subject to this section due to the changes made by this
- 11 <u>legislative bill, such state entity shall provide copies of such</u>
- 12 <u>contracts for inclusion in the data base beginning with contracts that</u>
- 13 <u>are active on and after January 1, 2017</u>; and
- (ii) A data base that includes copies of all expired contracts which
- were previously included in the data base described in subdivision (4)(a)
- 16 (i) (3)(a)(i) of this section and which have not been disposed of
- pursuant to policies and procedures adopted under subdivision (4)(e) (3)
- 18 (e) of this section. The data base required under this subdivision shall
- 19 be accessible by the public and searchable by vendor, by state entity
- 20 agency, board, commission, or department, and by dollar amount.
- 21 (b) The following shall be redacted or withheld from any contract
- 22 before such contract is included in a data base pursuant to subdivision
- 23 (4)(a) (3)(a) of this section:
- 24 (i) The social security number or federal tax identification number
- 25 of any individual or business;
- 26 (ii) Protected health information as such term is defined under the
- 27 federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, as
- 28 such act existed on January 1, 2013;
- 29 (iii) Any information which may be withheld from the public under
- 30 section 84-712.05; or
- 31 (iv) Any information that is confidential under state or federal

- 1 law, rule, or regulation.
- 2 (c) The following contracts shall be exempt from the requirements of
- 3 subdivision (4)(a) (3)(a) of this section:
- 4 (i) Contracts entered into by the Department of Health and Human
- 5 Services that are letters of agreement for the purpose of providing
- 6 specific services to a specifically named individual and his or her
- 7 family;
- 8 (ii) Contracts entered into by the University of Nebraska or any of
- 9 the Nebraska state colleges for the purpose of providing specific
- 10 services or financial assistance to a specifically named individual and
- 11 his or her family;
- 12 (iii) Contracts entered into by the Department of Veterans' Affairs
- 13 under section 80-401 or 80-403 for the purpose of providing aid to a
- 14 specifically named veteran and his or her family;
- 15 (iv) Contracts entered into by the State Energy Office for the
- 16 purpose of providing financing from the Dollar and Energy Saving Loan
- 17 program; and
- 18 (v) Contracts of employment for employees of any agency, board,
- 19 commission, or department of the state_entity. The exemption provided in
- 20 this subdivision shall not apply to contracts entered into by any agency,
- 21 board, commission, or department of the state entity to obtain the
- 22 services of an independent contractor.
- 23 (d) No agency, board, commission, or department of the state entity
- 24 shall structure a contract to avoid any of the requirements of
- 25 subdivision (4)(a) (3)(a) of this section.
- 26 (e) The Department of Administrative Services shall adopt policies
- 27 and procedures regarding the creation, maintenance, and disposal of
- 28 records pursuant to section 84-1212.02 for the contracts contained in the
- 29 data bases required under this section and the process by which agencies,
- 30 boards, commissions, and departments of the state entities provide copies
- 31 of the contracts required under this section.

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- 1 $(\underline{5}$ 4) All agencies, boards, commissions, and departments of the 2 state <u>entities</u> shall provide to the State Treasurer, at such times and in
- 3 such form as designated by the State Treasurer, such information as is
- 4 necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Taxpayer Transparency Act.
- 5 $(\underline{6} \ 5)$ Nothing in this section requires the disclosure of information
- 6 which is considered confidential under state or federal law or is not a
- 7 public record under section 84-712.05.
- 8 (6)(a) For purposes of this section, expenditure of state funds
- 9 means all expenditures of appropriated or nonappropriated funds by an
- 10 agency, board, commission, or department of the state from the state
- 11 treasury in forms including, but not limited to:
- 12 (i) Grants;
- 13 (ii) Contracts;
- 14 (iii) Subcontracts;
- 15 (iv) State aid to political subdivisions; and
- 16 (v) Tax refunds or credits that may be disclosed pursuant to the
- 17 Nebraska Advantage Act, the Nebraska Advantage Microenterprise Tax Credit
- 18 Act, the Nebraska Advantage Research and Development Act, or the Nebraska
- 19 Advantage Rural Development Act.
- 20 (b) Expenditure of state funds does not include the transfer of
- 21 funds between two agencies, boards, commissions, or departments of the
- 22 state or payments of state or federal assistance to an individual.
- 23 Sec. 4. Original sections 84-602 and 84-602.01, Reissue Revised
- 24 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 84-602.02, Revised Statutes Supplement,
- 25 2015, are repealed.
