- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid
- 2 in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 919, One Hundred
- Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016; and to state intent.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$191,200 from the
- 2 General Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$249,950 from the General Fund for
- 3 FY2017-18 to the Supreme Court, for Program 420, to aid in carrying out
- 4 the provisions of Legislative Bill 919, One Hundred Fourth Legislature,
- 5 <u>Second Session, 2016.</u>
- 6 Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
- 7 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$60,953
- 8 for FY2016-17 or \$81,270 for FY2017-18.
- 9 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$10,000 from the Supreme
- 10 Court Automation Cash Fund for FY2016-17 and (2) \$10,000 from the Supreme
- 11 Court Automation Cash Fund for FY2017-18 to the Supreme Court, for
- 12 Program 570, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill
- 13 919, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, Second Session, 2016.
- No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 15 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 16 section.
- 17 Sec. 3. It is the intent of the Legislature that funds appropriated
- 18 in this act be used by the Supreme Court to create a veterans treatment
- 19 court for any county in which a city of the metropolitan class is
- 20 <u>located</u>. Such court shall be considered a problem solving court and shall
- 21 be subject to the rules which shall be promulgated by the Supreme Court
- 22 for procedures to be implemented for the administration of such court.
- 23 By December 1, 2019, the Supreme Court shall report the viability of
- 24 the veterans treatment court model in Nebraska and electronically submit
- 25 a report to the Legislature containing the Supreme Court's
- 26 <u>recommendations concerning the continuation, expansion, or termination of</u>
- 27 <u>such courts in Nebraska.</u>
